SYNODAL JOURNEY: The Church is called to be a sign of God's love at work in the world. This is a challenge for all its members, as each one of us is asked to show God's love in our interactions with others. We are also asked to do this as local communities, as the community of Jesus' disciples. The Pope and the Irish Bishops are asking us to reflect on how we are faring as Christian communities around the country and around the world. They want to hear what all of us on the ground have to say. They want to know what our experience of the Church is like and how this could b improved. This is the aim of the synodal pathway on which we are being asked to embark.

We are invited to think about these and similar questions and on the sheets provide in both churches write down our reflections and drop the completed sheets into the offertory boxes in both churches. THE CHRISM MASS: This year Bishop Paul is inviting parishioners from every parish in the Diocese to participate in the Chrism Mass at St. Nathy's Cathedral, Ballaghaderreen, Monday 11th. April at 7.30 pm. He would particularly like those who are ministering in parishes such as Readers, Extraordinary Ministers of the Holy Communion, members of Parish Councils, Finance Committees, Sacramental Co-ordinators, Adoration Groups, Altar Societies, Sacristans, Parish Secretaries, all those involved in any way with parish activities to be present for this occasion. At this Mass the bishop blesses the oils to be used at the sacraments throughout the year. Priests also renew their commitment to service. Following the Mass, refreshments will be available in St. Nathy's College. This is an occasion to celebrate the unity of the people and priests of the diocese with the bishop. We look forward to a large attendance at this celebration.

SPECIAL COLLECTION: The Irish Bishops have requested that a Special Collection for Ukraine be taken up at all masses this weekend, 26/27 March. This collection is to support humanitarian efforts in Ukraine and especially the families and children who have had to flee their homeland in advance of the Russian invasion. The proceeds of this collection will be directed to Caritas Internationalis, the helping hand of the church in Ukraine and surrounding regions. The bishops appreciate that rising prices here are a real problem for many people so whatever you can give will be greatly appreciated. A dedicated collection box, clearly marked, will be available in both churches.
