FEASTDAYS FOR THE COMING WEEK:

Wednesday 6th. June. St. Maria Goretti. 1690-1902 Maria, the third of seven children born in 1890 to a poor Italian family was a pious, kind and helpful girl and also very beautiful. The family couldn't afford a place of their own so Maria's father arranged for his family to share a house with another family, a father and two sons. One of the sons was called Alessandro and one day he arranged that Maria would be alone in the house. He approach her with immoral intent and when Maria refused to let him have his way with her, in a rage, he stabbed her fourteen times. She was taken to hospital on a horse drawn ambulance and was operated on for two hours. She lived for another twenty four hours, and died on the evening of the 6th July 1902, but not before she had forgiven her murderer. Alessandro narrowly escaped being lynched, he was tried and sentenced to thirty years penal servitude. Maria was beatified in 1927 and canonised in 1950 and her mother was present at the canonisation. Alessandro repented of his wrongdoing and spent his last years in a Capuchin monastery and died in 1970.
